

## **Davening Notes**

1 Starting Rosh Hashanah thru Yom Kippur, we make special insertions into the silent prayers and repetitions:

“Zochrainu L’chaim”; “Mi Chamocha”; **“HaMelech HaKadosh”**; “HaMelech HaMishpat” (during weekday prayers); “U’chtov L’Chaim”; and “B’Sefer Chaim”.

2 We also add “Avinu Malkeinu” after the repetition in weekday morning prayers and mincha (page 120 in regular Artscroll Siddur)

3 On Rosh Hashanah, if one is praying by oneself, one can say the special prayers in the repetition of Shacharis and Musaf and even use Hashem’s name.

4 On Monday morning, we continue to recite Selichot. **See Note # 6 below for pages.**

5 If one is reciting Selichot without a Minyan, then one does NOT recite Yud Gimel Midot (the Thirteen Attributes of

Hashem), and most do not recite the paragraph before (Kel Melech)

Pages 46 to 74 (remember to make insertions for Shabbat on pages 60, bottom of 68, and 70), on Page 76 recite VaY'chulu (top) and Magen Avot (third paragraph), Page 78 (L'Dovid Mizmor), page 84 (Aleynu), Page 86 (L'Dovid), Page 88 (Adon Olam)

## **Shabbat, September 19, 2020**

### **Shacharit**

Sidur Pages 184 (bottom) to 188, 192 (second paragraph) to 194, 214 (bottom) to 216, 220-264, 266 (bottom), 278 to 288 (read bottom for Shabbat), 284, 288-304 (make insertions for Shabbat on 300).

Repetition: the following piyutim prayers are optional - Hashem's name may be used: 314 (Ata Hu), any of the bolded lines on 314, 318, 326, and 330 (l'kayl orech din)

Torah reading: 402-410 (tops of pages), Haftarah 416-424 (tops of pages).

## **Musaf**

Page 428, first paragraph of Yekum Purkan, page 440 (Ashrei), page 448-468 (include insertions for Shabbat on 452 and 454 and top of 458),

Repetition: the following piyutim prayers are optional - Hashem's name may be used: 478-484 (Melech Elyon, U'nesaneh Tokef), 490-492 (V'chol Ma'aminim)

## **After Musaf**

Page 586-592, 178-180 (Shir shel Yom, L'David, Adon Olam)

## **Mincha**

Pages 598 to 602, 604 (top line Va'Ani), 698 (Torah reading), 612-620 (include insertions for Shabbat on 616 and 618), 626-628 (Aleinu)

## **Second Day Rosh HaShana, Motzei Shabbos**

**Saturday, September 19, 2020**

Maariv

Start on p. 50 with Baruch till the bottom of page 58.

On p. 60 say the middle paragraph Tiku Bachodesh Shofar.

Turn to p. 62 for the Shemoneh Esrai. Say from p 62 until p. 74. Remember to include the bold printing that is, on p 62, Zachrainu Lchaim, p 64, Me Chamocha, p 72, Uchdsov Lchaim and on page 74, Besefer Hachaim.

On page 66, at the bottom, to say Hamelech Hakadosh.

As well, remember to say Vatodeyanu in the grey box on page 68.

After finishing the Shemoneh Esrai, turn to page 78 for Ledavid Mizmor.

Page 84 Aleinu

Page 86 Ledavid Hashem Ori.

Sunday, September 20, 2020

Shachris

Start on p. 136 and go to the bottom of p. 138 and say what applies to you.

Afterwards, turn to page 180 and go to page 196.

Turn to page 214 and go to the bottom of page 260.

Turn to page 262 and go till three lines from the bottom on page 264.

Turn to page 266 and start from three lines from the bottom.

Turn to page 278 going till page 282 saying the top part only.

Turn to page 284 and say till the bottom of the page.

Turn to page 288 and say the first four lines from the right-hand side only.

Continue on page 288 and go till the middle of 296.

The Shemoneh Esrai begins on p 296 and runs till page 304. Remember to include the bold printing that is, on p 296, Zachrainu Lchaim, p 298, Me Chamocha, p 302, Uchdsov Lchaim and on page 304, Besefer Hachaim.

On page 298, at the bottom, to say Hamelech Hakadosh.

After the Shemoneh Esrai, turn to page 384 for the Avinu Malkeinu and runs till the middle of page 388.

If one wants to look at the Torah reading it begins on the bottom of page 402 and runs till page 410 at the bottom. One should only look at the bottom part for the second day.

The other reading is on page 412 five lines from the bottom and goes till page 414 the first three lines.

The Haftarah for the second day runs from the bottom of page 416 till the bottom of page 424 only reading the bottom part.

Turn to page 440 for Ashrai say till three lines from the bottom.

Mussaf

The Mussaf Shemoneh Esrai runs from page 448 to page 468. Remember to include the bold printing that is, on p 448, Zachrainu Lchaim, p 448, Me Chamocha, p 466, Uchsov Lchaim and on page 468, Besefer Hachaim.

On page 450, towards the bottom, to say Hamelech Hakadosh.

After Shemoneh Esrai, turn to page 586 and read till the bottom of page 588.

Turn to page 590 for Aleinu and say till the middle of page 592.

Turn to page 170 and say the Psalm for Sunday.

Turn to page 178 for Ledavid.

Mincha

Turn to page 598 for Ashrai and say till page 602 towards the bottom.

Turn to page 612 for the Mincha Shemoneh Esrai and runs till page 620.

Remember to include the bold printing that is, on p 612, Zachrainu Lchaim, p 612, Me Chamocha, p 618, Uchdsov Lchaim and on page 620, Besefer Hachaim.

On page 616, towards the bottom, to say Hamelech Hakadosh.

After the Shemoneh Esrai, turn to page 622 for Avinu Malkeinu and say till page 624 on the bottom.

Turn to page 626 for Aleinu and say till the middle of page 628.

Maariv

On page 646 start with Vehu Rachum skip Barchu and say till the middle of page 652.

Turn to page 654 for the Maariv Shemoneh Esrai and it runs till page 664 in the middle.

Remember to say Atah Chonantanu in the middle of page 656.

Remember to include the bold printing that is, on p 654, Zachrainu Lchaim, p 656, Me Chamocha, p 662, Uchdsov Lchaim and on page 662, Besefer Hachaim.

On page 656, towards the bottom, to say Hamelech Hakadosh.

On page 658 in the paragraph of Hashiva to say Hamelech Hamishpat.

After Shemoneh Esrai, turn to page 666 for Aleinu.

Turn to page 670 for Ledavid.
