Friday	March 26	7:20 pm	Mincha/Kabbalat Shabbat & Candle-lighting. <b>Remember to light a 48-hour candle as well at this point, so that one can light the candles for the 1st day (Saturday night) and the 2nd day (Sunday night) of Yom Tov from it.</b>
Shabbat	March 27	<b>7:00 am</b>	Shacharit – <b>Please note early time to accommodate latest time to eat Chametz</b>
